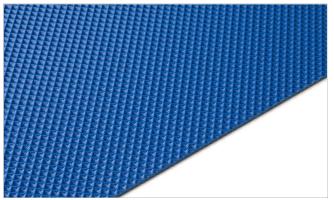


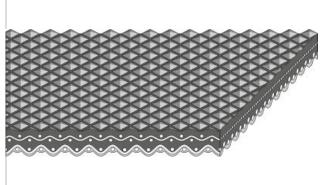

Do not go below initial elongation (epsilon) ~ 0.5%, Install the slack belt and tension until running perfectly under the full belt load
